

ALPEX SHOW 1971

TREASURER'S REPORT

In 2020-21, there were no Shows which generate income, but there were fewer meetings and less expenses from activities. In addition, we had large donations of mint stamps that kept our mailing/postage costs down which avoided any loss for the year.

Unfortunately, looking at the 2021-22 budget with the increased room rental cost and a return to more normal activity, there was a significant loss projected. Different budget scenarios were looked at. Some non-recurring or unnecessary costs were taken out or reduced, and ways of generating additional revenue at the auctions were discussed, such as a 50/50 split raffle and higher revenue auction items. In conclusion, an increase of annual dues was also recommended.

<u>DUES</u>

The increase of Dues was discussed at length at the July Board meeting. With annual dues last year at \$12, there hasn't been a dues increase in over 40 years. But the major reason for our deficit is the increase in room rental which has doubled compared to the Leonard Post along with total value of auction sales low.

We also looked at our dues versus other Clubs and recognized that our dues in comparison were very low. We believe that the value of membership in the Buffalo Stamp Club is greater than \$12 per year, and we hope that you agree.

Therefore, the Board unanimously agreed to raise the dues to \$20 per year.

The Board will also need to work on other income generating or cost reducing efforts to assure financial stability. All costs are going up, even postage.

Meanwhile, what value does the Club bring to you:

- A monthly newsletter, typically 6 pages in full color, with news and items of interest.
- Monthly meetings & auctions to engage with other members to meet together and enjoy our hobby.
- After-meeting socials to build relationships and learn from each other.

Presentations should start up again, but we need to find another venue. We're currently considering West Seneca Library where we can meet for free in a nice conference room setting.

So, let us know what value the Club means for you! We'd love to hear from you. How can we increase the value of the Club to you!
